Description

Working collaboratively with classroom teachers, parents, and school leadership, the interventionist identifies student needs, implements research-based instructional strategies, monitors progress, and fosters student success while modeling Catholic values and promoting the dignity of every child.

Essential Responsibilities

- Provide small-group and individualized instruction in reading, mathematics, and other identified academic areas.
- Design and implement evidence-based intervention plans that address students' individual learning needs.
- Work closely with classroom teachers to identify students requiring intervention and coordinate instructional support.
- Participate in student support meetings, parent conferences, and faculty meetings as needed.
- Communicate regularly with teachers and families regarding student progress and recommendations.
- Support and uphold the mission, philosophy, and teachings of the Catholic Church.
