This position is responsible for developing, managing, and supervising every aspect of the school's athletic programs. The Athletic Director is responsible for leading and managing the athletic program in a manner consistent with the mission and philosophy of Saint Cecilia Academy and the teachings of the Catholic Church. The AD will promote a culture of excellence, sportsmanship, integrity, and virtue across all athletic endeavors while fostering the holistic development of young women in mind, body, and spirit. The athletic director serves multiple constituencies: students, parents, coaches, faculty/staff, and administration. The athletic director is often the first point of contact with prospective families and therefore must be passionate about the vision of SCA athletics and an outstanding communicator.
