Planning & Instruction

- Plan and prepare daily lessons and materials in alignment with Saint Matthew School curriculum and TN State Standards
- Utilize school-wide tracking and tech systems to collect, enter, and analyze students' academic and behavioral data daily
- Ensure both academic and behavioral gradebooks are maintained with accurate information, in accordance with school-wide deadlines and policy
- Work effectively with students of varying abilities and learning styles
- Collaborate with students, colleagues, and other members of the school community

School-Based Duties & Faculty Engagement

- Enforce, uphold, and exhibit school's values, student management policies, and culture systems
- Participate in school events that occur outside of normal school hours, such as parent-teacher conferences, field trips, SSP meetings, and open-house
- Engage in ongoing professional development
- Attend weekly faculty/staff meetings after school on Wednesdays from 3:00-4:00
