Modifications change, reduce, or lower the learning expectation. They alter what is to be learned.

Modifications involve substantive changes to: the curriculum a child studies; the way a child is assessed; the type of instructional techniques used to teach the child critical skills such as reading, writing, or mathematics.

The purpose of modifications is to allow children who have a specific disability or specialized educational needs an opportunity to receive necessary therapeutic or educational interventions in order to master critical skills. *NOTE: Students receiving modifications may also receive accommodations. However, students only receiving accommodations will not receive modifications.*
