



Tennessee ESA PROGRAM

What is the Education Savings Account (ESA) Program?

Education Savings Accounts are administered by the Tennessee Department of Education.

ESA funds provide additional school choices to families who are zoned to a Metro Nashville public school and are income-eligible. Families can utilize ESA funds toward tuition, fees, books, and other educational expenses at participating private schools.

HOW TO ENROLL

WHEN TO ACT



Enroll in the State ESA Program NOW!

Then notify the Catholic Schools Office by August 2 for the 2022-2023 school year.

Only 5,000 ESAs available statewide.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE



Students who attended a Metro Nashville public school last school year for the full year. Students entering MNPS for the first time this school year for grades K-12.

HOW TO QUALIFY



Federal income guidelines apply. A family of four with an income of \$72,150 or less would qualify.
