

GIFT PROCESSING RECOMMENDATIONS

- All gifts made via check to the Bishop's Annual Appeal for Ministries (BAAM) during Commitment Weekend should be sent to the Lockbox for processing using the Tyvek envelopes provided.
- All cash gifts to BAAM should be sent to the diocese for processing.
- All BAAM gifts should remain sealed inside their envelope. This enables donor information to stay with the gift itself and allow for gift acknowledgement by the diocese and parish.
- If you receive any cash donations, or gifts/payments to the Legacy Campaign or other special collections, please send them to the diocese for processing.
