Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

Words with capitalized initial letters have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- **Account** means a unique account created for you to access our Service or parts of our Service.
- **Affiliate** means an entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party.
- **Company** (referred to as either "the Company," "We," "Us," or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Diocese of Nashville, 2800 McGavock Pike, Nashville, TN 37214.
- **Cookies** are small files placed on your device that store browsing history details.
- **Country** refers to the United States of America.
- **Device** means any device that can access the Service, such as a computer, cellphone, or tablet.
- **Personal Data** is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.
- **Service** refers to the Website.
- **Service Provider** means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Company.

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service and may include information such as:

- Your device's IP address
- Browser type and version
- Pages visited
- Time and date of visit
- Time spent on pages
- Unique device identifiers

When accessing the Service through a mobile device, additional information such as mobile operating system, device type, and mobile browser may be collected.

Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use Cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our Service and store certain information.

Types of Cookies Used:

- **Necessary Cookies** – Essential for service functionality.
- **Cookies Policy Acceptance Cookies** – Identify if users accepted cookies.

- **Functionality Cookies** – Remember your preferences.
